

**AFRO EUROPEAN EXCURSION
PARIS.LONDON. AMSTERDAM
October 11-20, 2019**

DAY 1 (Friday, October 11) Arrival Paris - Taste of Montmartre



Embark on a culinary tour of Paris's Montmartre neighborhood, one of the city's most charming neighborhoods. Sample delicacies like croissants and éclairs at a local patisserie, enjoy a guided tasting of various cheeses at a fromagerie and satisfy your sweet tooth at a classic chocolaterie. Of course, no gourmet tour of Paris would be complete without a stop at a boulangerie, where you'll learn the proper way to eat a baguette in France. 3 hr. Walking tour.

DAY 2 (Saturday, October 12) – Château Rouge

Explore Château Rouge, an area with a remarkable mix of colors and cultures that features black African boutiques, restaurants, and a market street with several African food vendors. Then venture into Barbès for a taste of North Africa in Paris. 2 hr. Walking tour.



Afterwards see the city traveling on a double decker bus. Take in sights like the Louvre Museum, Moulin Rouge cabaret club, Notre-Dame Cathedral and the iconic Eiffel Tower as you listen to informative audio commentary. Create a personalized itinerary of the sights you want to see.

In the evening immerse yourself in Parisian nightlife on an entertaining pub crawl through the city. Free shots, discounts on drinks and entry to the club.

DAY 3 (Sunday, October 13) – Black History in Paris



Explore the Luxembourg Garden and learn about the histories of such luminaries as Richard Wright, Alexandre Dumas, Victor Séjour, and Henry O. Tanner. Learn about the myth of the black Statue of Liberty and see the contemporary sculpture that commemorates the abolition of slavery in the French colonies. 2 hr. Walking tour.

Afterwards see the city traveling on a double decker bus. Take in sights like the Louvre Museum, Moulin Rouge cabaret club, Notre-Dame Cathedral and the iconic Eiffel Tower as you listen to informative audio commentary. Create a personalized itinerary of the sights you want to see.

DAY 4 (Monday, October 14) Eiffel Tower/Seine River Cruise

Experience the Eiffel Tower while dining on a delicious three-course lunch at the Eiffel Tower's Restaurant 58, after viewing the tower's second floor. Later in the afternoon enjoy boat cruise on the river Seine.



DAY 5 (Tuesday, October 15) Outlet Shopping/Day of Leisure

Indulge your inner shopaholic with a day trip from Paris to La Vallée Village, an open-air shopping center. With more than 115 boutiques to choose from (including fashion icons like Jimmy Choo, Diane Von Furstenburg and Armani) and savings on last season's collections of at least 33 percent off retail prices, it's a shopper's paradise (**optional**). Relax and prepare for departure to London.

DAY 6 (Wednesday, October 16) London

Arrive in London by train. Afterwards see the city traveling on a double decker bus and complimentary tours. Take in sights like Westminster, Notting Hill, Big Ben, Buckingham Palace and Thames River Sightseeing Cruise.

Explore the British Museum exhibition on the diverse cultural life of Africa being expressed through everyday objects and unique works of art since ancient times. The Museum's collection of over 200,000 African items encompasses archaeological and contemporary material from across the continent.

DAY 7 (Thursday, October 17) African Presence in London

Embark on a guided walking tour through hundreds of years of the African presence and contribution to London's way of life. Discover secret alleyways and enormous buildings all connected to Africa and the Caribbean in ways which the owners do not want you to know. Find out about

Black loyalists and African revolutionaries. Uncover the submerged links between racism, trade, religion, slavery and politics which are evident in the very streets and buildings of the oldest part of London. 2hr. Walking tour. Afterwards see the city traveling on a double decker bus and complimentary tours.

DAY 8 (Friday, October 18) Amsterdam

Arrive in Amsterdam by train. Afterwards see the city traveling on a double decker bus and explore Amsterdam at your own pace. See all that Amsterdam has to offer, including top-notch art galleries and eclectic neighborhoods. Create a sightseeing itinerary that suits your schedule.

Red Light District Tour (**optional**) - Discover the history of this centuries-old profession while you walk past the windows and learn the function of the red lights from local guide. 2hr. Walking tour.

Day 9 (Saturday, October 19) – Amsterdam Black Heritage

See the city traveling on a double decker bus and explore Amsterdam at your own pace. In the afternoon experience Amsterdam Black Heritage on foot and explore the hidden history throughout the Amsterdam canals of the traces of slavery. 90min. Walking tour. *





Explore Amsterdam Coffee Shop Culture and Food Tasting (**optional**). Lead by local guide, stroll through the narrow lanes and squares, dip into Amsterdam's liberal coffee shops and learn about the history and relaxed attitude to cannabis in the city. Visit two bohemian coffee shops and enjoy food tasting along the way.

Later in the evening receive an interesting introduction to the city's globally renowned nightlife with an Amsterdam Pub Crawl. Follow a guide to a selection of handpicked dance bars and nightclubs and enjoy a complimentary drink in each venue. Conclude your tour in an exclusive nightclub and continue dancing the night away if you wish.

DAY 10 (Sunday, October 20) – Amsterdam Departure

Hotel check-out and departure. *Amsterdam Black Heritage canal tour – 3 hrs. - 12:00pm. An



unforgettable journey through time exploring the black presence and traces of slavery visible from the 'Dutch Golden Age'. This tour is available for those who did not select the walking tour or as an optional tour for an additional fee. Please arrange departing flights accordingly.
